- Current National Registry or WA State certified EMT-B. (Successful completion of Thurston County EMT Protocol Test within 30 days of appointment.)

- NWCG FF II (Wildland Red Card)

Disqualifiers:

- Criminal Activity, candidates must pass criminal background investigation
- Driving candidates must pass driving record evaluation
- Drug Use candidates must pass drug screening. Illegal drug use or exposure within 3 years.
- Lying of falsifying documents during any stage of the hiring process. Dishonorable discharge from United States armed forces.
